DISCOUNT FOR PRE-ARRANGED GUESTS

Inverloch Surfside offer discounted rates for your overnight guests. The special rate of \$15 per adult and \$7.50 per child under 18 per night applies to pre-registered guests only.

To be eligible for the discounts you must register your guests <u>PRIOR</u> to their stay & payment must be made on booking or on arrival for their stay.

- Note through letter drop in the front door.

Any fees that have not been, both, notified and paid for by the end of your guest stay will revert to the ad-hoc rates.

Any fees that remain Overdue by 14 days will have their boom gate pass suspended until your account is back in terms.

SITE AUDITS

This year, for obvious reasons, formal site audits will not take place. However we ask all site holders to please perform annual maintenance on their sites when they return to the park.

Important items to pay attention to include removal of cobwebs, clearing of gutters, painting where required and a general tidy up. This helps protect your investment as well as keeping up standards within the park.

This year we will be working with site holders to ensure maintenance items are done and we will communicate with each personally.

PARK UPGRADES

The Covid 19 pandemic has had an impact on the way we approach future upgrades to the park.

The games room upgrade is being reassessed as we have run into planning difficulties, and are uncertain of how we can use this space in the near future under the rules that might apply.

For the immediate term we will be concentrating on the open spaces available on the oval and how we can deliver activities and space for site holders to get together and have fun, keeping in mind we need to abide by the rules in place at the time.

CABIN AND VAN SALES

The level of enquiry for the purchase of sites is at an all time high as Victorians look for local options for their holidays. The start to this financial year has been good with 5 sites sold and 2 sites currently under offer. When travel restrictions ease we have a 3AW radio advertising campaign organised to promote the park and the sale of sites.

If you have any friends or family interested in a site and have been looking please let them know to get in early. Regional purchasers can inspect now and any Metro purchasers can have a virtual inspection sent to them, or a live inspection over facetime
